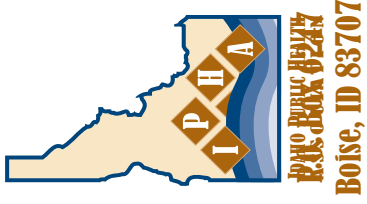

- Recipient of a three-year, \$90,000.00 American Public Health Association Affiliate Capacity-Building Grant.
